To get to Tarbes: consider sustainable transport





Train

- To travel in train, in France, you can access prices and train timetables on the website
 SNCF Connect (you can choose « direct travels» to avoid connections).
- <u>Interrail</u> is also an option to consider to travel in Europe.
- <u>Trainline</u> and <u>SNCF Connect</u> are some website which allowed us to travel in train, bus or even carpooling.

Bus and carpooling

- Like everywhere in Europe, <u>Flixbus</u> and <u>Blablacar</u> stays a good way to get to Tarbes and to travel in the region when you arrived.
- **Busbud** also offers bus transport to coming in Tarbes.
- There are also many possibilities with **Blablacar**.

Today, all buses offer Wi-Fi, which makes the journey easier, and there are no weight restrictions for your luggage - just think about it!







Coming to Tarbes from...



Airport Paris CDG

If you want to visit Paris when you arrive in France, you can choose a way of transport that gets you at **the center of Paris**:

To come **in train** since Paris, there are lines that take you directly to Tarbes, or with connections :

You can also take a domestic flight to the airports of Toulouse-Blagnac (TLS), Pau-Pyrénées (PUF), or even Tarbes-Lourdes-Pyrénées (LDE), from the following two Paris airports :

- Paris Orly (ORY)
- Paris Roissy Charles de Gaulle (CDG)

Airport Toulouse-Blagnac

If you want to visit Toulouse upon arrival in France, you can choose a way of transport that gets you at **the** center of Toulouse.

To find out how to get around Toulouse, click on the link below for maps of the different means of **transport in the city**.

To go directly to Tarbes, you can take a train from the Gare SNCF with the "**Navette aéroport**".



Coming to Tarbes from...



Airport Pau-Pyrénées

If you want to visit Pau upon arrival, you can take the "Idelis 10" shuttle bus. It links <u>Pau-Pyrénées</u> <u>airport</u> with Pau city centre. This service operates from Monday to Saturday, from 7.00 am to 7.00 pm

To get to Tarbes from the Pau's SNCF train station, a shuttle leaves the airport every hour.

If you arrive after 7.45 pm, a Sunday, or a public holiday, you'll have to take a taxi.



Airport Tarbes-Lourdes-Pyrénées

The <u>airport of Tarbes-Lourdes-Pyrénées</u> is just 10km from the centre of Tarbes.

The bus' lines TLP Mobilités n°TL and n°T7 link the airport to the gare SNCF of Tarbes (near to the city centre), for 1€ (1,08\$).

Monthly cost of living in Tarbes


- The average monthly rent in Tarbes's private rentals housing is 350€ (excluding utility charges)
- Housing in student residences is less expensive, but the average monthly rent is between 289€ to 301€, and can be much higher depending on the type of residence and the services offered
- In 2023, the average cost of back-to-school expenses for a non-scholarship student was 3024€

Documentation

You can consult and borrow **a wide range of documents** at the library: printed and audio books, periodicals, CDs, DVDs with French-English dubbing and subtitles, as well as a large collection of electronic documentation covering the following areas:

- Scientific and technical documents in UTTOP's teaching and research fields,
- Cultural resources (documentaries, novels, comic strips, etc.)
- Language resources for learning French, English, German, Spanish, Italian and Portuguese, aso.

You can also use staplers, bookbinders and, on request, headphones or even PCs under certain conditions. You will have access to the various documents in the two campus libraries. For more information about borrowing, please contact bibliotheque@uttop.fr

Collection French Language Foreign (FLF)

Exchange students will have access to **a FLF collection** to help them perfect their French and complement the FLF courses they will be taking at UTTOP.



Sportive activities

The Sportive association (A.S.)

The A.S. welcomes students wishing to take part in one or more sporting activities throughout the school year.

The membership fee is €30* (whether you stay for one or two semesters) and helps finance sports activities organised by the association :

- <u>In class</u>: Mountain bike / Hiking / Rock climbing / Snowboard / Rafting / Classic courses.
- <u>Outside class</u>: Golf / Swimming / Tennis / Badminton / Bodybuilding / Horse riding / Basketball / Hand / Volleyball / Football / Rugby / Dance and Fitness / Combative sport / Karting (with a financial contribution from the student) / Ski training (paid by students)

*an additional fee may be required depending on the activity

The « Starter Pack »

The Starter Pack is a set of items (crockery, blankets, aso.) that Club International lends you to help you get settled in. It is valid throughout your stay in Tarbes. You will be asked to pay a deposit in exchange for the items borrowed, which will be fully refunded if the starter pack is returned cleaned when you leave.

The « Buddies »

The Buddy programme is a sponsorship programme for foreign exchange students by ENIT students.

This programme offers foreign students the opportunity to be in contact with an ENIT student as soon as they arrive in France. The aim is to build friendship between the students so that the new incoming students become familiar with the French culture.

It is the fruit of the collective efforts of an entire class, who coordinate logistics, project management, security, technical aspects, aso. for a single evening of celebration on a given theme.





- Tiers-Lieu du Lien : offers a wide range of events
- <u>Farmers' markets:</u> Place Marcadieu on Thursday mornings and Halle Brauhauban on Saturday mornings.

- N'PY and non-N'PY ski resorts offer a wide choice of activities for your weekend. Buses run from the centre of Tarbes.
- Beaches of the Landes and the Basque Country are just a short train or bus ride from Tarbes.

Tarbes city centre is well connected to UTTOP by several bus routes in the TLP Mobilités network.

Prices:

o Single ticket: **€1** o 10-trip pass: **€9**

o Under-25s season ticket: €10/month

Tarbes' public transport network (bus), self-service bicycles and electric cars are managed by TLP Mobilités.


Buses lines map in Tarbes.

The town of Tarbes has set up a self-service bicycle hire scheme that you can take from the town centre to the UTTOP and vice versa.
